The conference will be held on April 15-16, 2026, NSTU, Novosibirsk, Prospekt K. Marksa, 20.

Form of participation: face-to-face (including online connection and video report of nonresident participants) with a report and publication, with a report without publication, remote (with publication only), as a listener.

Russian (for foreign participants), English, German, French

Terms of participation

Young scholars without a scientific degree, postgraduate, graduate, undergraduate and high school students, whose reports reflect the results of the study and correspond to the declared areas of the conference, are invited to participate in the conference:

- ✓ AI-driven Technological and Social Progress
- ✓ Navigating through Language and Culture with AI
- ✓ AI Changing Translation Practice and Research
- ✓ AI Changing Education Practice and Research

After the conference the collection of articles will be published and placed on the website of the scientific electronic library **eLIBRARY.ru** with the indexing **Russian Science Citation Index**.

✓ All in-person and remote reporters will participate in the **contest of reports**; the assessment criteria are:

- the structure of the report (relevance of the research, purpose, theoretical bases, methodology, research results),
- the content of the report (the in-depth consideration of the issues, the novelty of the research, the author's own contribution, the correspondence of the results to modern trends in the development of science),
- presentation of the report (language literacy, fluency in material and scientific terminology, clarity, the ability to take part in a scientific discussion, compliance with the rules).

✓ All remote participants take part in the **contest of scientific articles**, where the structure and content of the article (see the criteria for evaluating reports), language literacy, and scientific style of presentation are assessed.
